WHEREAS, on May 9, 2000, the Superior Court in Mohave County issued Administrative Orders 2000-20 and 2000-21 (together the "Order") which mandated the Mohave County Board of Supervisors, through the County Manager and County Treasurer, along with those subject to their supervision and control, to immediately increase funding to the judicial branch in Mohave County by \$310,033 in accordance with the summaries set forth in Exhibit A and as provided through administrative orders set forth in Exhibit B; and

WHEREAS, on June 14, 2000, the Supreme Court of Arizona denied a request for an interlocutory stay of the Order; and

WHEREAS, on June 19, 2000, the Mohave County Board of Supervisors passed, approved, and adopted Resolution No. 2000-297 resolving that the sum of \$217,970 be transferred from amounts appropriated for the County General Fund Contingency Account (County Account No. 100-01-1000-479.60) for FY 1999-2000 to the account for funds appropriated for the Superior Court in Mohave County (County Account No. 100-01-2901), and that additional amounts, up to an additional total of \$33,105, may be transferred from the Contingency Account to County Account No. 100-01-2901, on an as-needed basis as determined by the County Chief Financial Officer; and

WHEREAS, the Mohave County Board of Supervisors' Resolution No. 2000-297 fails to comply with the Order as well as the Arizona Supreme Court Order dated June 14, 2000.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the Mohave County Treasurer pay to the Clerk of the Superior Court in Mohave County the total sum of \$92,063 by the close of business on June 23, 2000.
