WHEREAS, fiscal year 1999-2000 has now ended and, as of the close of business on June 30, 2000, the Mohave County Board of Supervisors had failed to comply with Administrative orders 2000-20 and 2000-21 and had further failed to authorize and direct the County Treasurer to pay the amount set forth in Administrative Order 2000-31;

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED rescinding Administrative Order 2000-31.
